

## EASY DIVERS POOL REFRESHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- If you have had a new medical condition/surgery/serious illness/respiratory illness or are on new medication since you completed your diving training, it is your responsibility to consult with a doctor before booking your pool refresher. If this is the case please download the PADI diving medical form from our website, take it to your doctor for signing and bring it along when you come to your pool refresher session
- 2. You hold a minimum dive qualification of PADI Open Water or equivalent and you show us evidence of your diving qualification before your session
- 3. You can show us evidence of a logged dive within the last 3 years. If you haven't logged a dive for 3 years or more, you need to discuss your requirements with us because we may refer you for a PADI Reactivate
- 4. We will offer you a full refund less bank charges if you cancel 14 days prior to your booked session
- 5. If you cancel with less than 14 days notice we will offer you an alternative session date, but there is no money back option unless you can show us proof of a positive Covid 19 test or order to self isolate or a lockdown prevents you from attending
- 6. If you have booked a pool refresher so that you can come on a Lundy dive trip with us, we will offer you an alternative date or a full refund if we have to cancel your dive trip due to unsafe conditions
- 7. We offer dive equipment for hire in standard small, medium, large and extra large sizes. If you think you are of a non-standard size it is worth discussing this with us before you book, so that we can make sure we have equipment that will fit
- 8. We have allowed for an intensive 30 minute training session in the pool. If you require longer to practice skills, this will be charged at an extra cost
